
### You Are My King

## An update from the Distributor

In response to many queries about our office hours, I thought I should set the record straight! KYB4M doesn't really have an 'office'! KYB4M is run by a volunteer committee; there are no paid staff members. The Distribution takes place in my lounge/family room; hopefully when the grandchildren aren't visiting or staying over! As you can imagine, four times a year, there are two very busy weeks, while the orders are processed.

Orders for each new study come to me by phone or mail, by a given date. This allows me to compile the bulk order for CWCI. They send the order to the printer by a set date and the printer delivers the bulk order to my house (photo on next page). Hence the need to encourage orders to be on time, and our \$5 fine for those who are routinely late, which we will be enforcing.

The next step is for the orders to be compiled with inserts and packaged ready for posting.

Banking usually takes place after the posting, as a bulk deposit.

Most terms, about 50 groups order the new study, while some continue fortnightly on the previous one. I am always very encouraged at 'order time', to hear of the work that God is doing in the lives of KYB4M members, and the fellowship and outreach opportunities that come as a result.

One of our groups in Grenfell NSW, have made a real impact on their community. They have William Morrow, one of the founders of KYB4M, as their minister at the Presbyterian and Uniting churches. The KYB4M group is made up of members from both churches. The group volunteered to work at the food donation centre in the Anglican

Church, to serve the needy in the district with donated fruit/veg/staples etc. Two non-Christian women, who were volunteers from the community were so amazed by the love and unity that these Christians from various churches were displaying, that they made enquiries about Christianity. William's wife invited them home for a chat, and they have given their lives to Christ! Praise the Lord! The KYB4M group is now a home group for these women as they go through basic Christian studies with them.

Another group in Emu Heights NSW, have dinners together, and at Christmas time they decided to make Christmas boxes for some of the elderly in their church, to thank them for their service over many years. The response has been one of deep emotion and gratitude.

In Traralgon VIC, a new group has been started at a Retirement Village. The leader, Nanette, started by a letter box drop in the Village. Many were from various church backgrounds. There were 18 initial responses. They have divided into two, and one group has started with the Jesus of Nazareth Study, that CWCI offers to new groups that have never engaged in serious Bible Study before. They are hoping to all come on board for the next study later in the year.

The excitement has been expressed by a few groups, in anticipation of our new study of the Holy Spirit. I can't wait for the boxes to arrive, to get my first look at the content.

I will be posting out with prayers for you all, as you share the Bible to grow together in Christ.
